



FESTIVAL REGULATIONS

- Report to the hall at least 10 minutes before your class begins.
- An **original copy** of all music is to be handed to the Adjudicator's Secretary for the adjudicator's use before you play. To adhere to **Canadian copyright laws, no photocopies are allowed.**
- Out of respect for all performers, do not enter or leave the festival while numbers are being performed or adjudication given.
- Adjudicators are not to be approached by any students, teachers, or parents. Any concerns or questions during the Festival sessions are to be submitted in writing to the Festival President or Secretary.
- Only those participants entering two or more solo classes in each category are eligible for Scholarships.
- The adjudicator chooses scholarship winners and scholarships are awarded at the discretion of the adjudicator. Scholarships and awards may be redirected depending on classes entered/not entered and the number of entries in each area.
- Only the winner and runner-up in each class will be marked numerically. The other competitors will be given a rating only.
- Participants receiving awards or scholarships are expected to be present at the Awards Concert.
